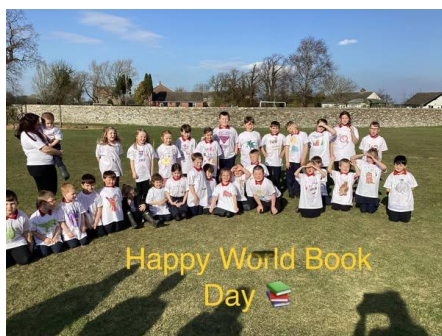
Dear Parents, Carers and Children,
