

This week in Maths Class Two will be consolidating their understanding of place value in numbers with up to four digits. You can help at home by writing and saying numbers together, especially when they cross a hundred- e.g. 99, 100, 101, 102 etc. They will be revising number bonds to ten, hundred and thousand, and beginning to learn and revise times tables. With Mrs Thomson we continue work on shape, space and direction.

In English Class Two will be continuing to hear and respond to the Russian folk tale 'The Firebird'. We will be writing creatively and learning about different sentence types. We will all be focusing on handwriting and letter formation- please help children to practise at home. We will continue spelling, grammar and punctuation work based on the Firebird with Mrs Thomson.

The children are expected to read for 10-20 minutes each night and for an adult to write a note in their reading record, including any difficult words that they don't know. All the children know that there are prizes to be given for any child who has read with an adult for 25 times in a half term!
