

This week in Maths Class Two will be extending their understanding of place value in numbers with up to four digits by solving a wide variety of problems designed to develop 'varied fluency'- the ability to understand and represent numbers and problems in different ways. We continue to memorise number bonds and times tables- please help by testing your child. With Mrs Thomson we continue work on shape, space and direction.

In English Class Two will be concluding our work on 'The Firebird' before we move onto a different folk tale. We will hear the end of the story and respond with drama, creative writing and poetry. We will also hear a slightly different version and compare. We continue to focus on handwriting and letter formation- please help children to practise at home. Spelling, grammar and punctuation work based on the Firebird continues with Mrs Thomson.

The children are expected to read for 10-20 minutes each night and for an adult to write a note in their reading record, including any difficult words that they don't know. Five minutes a night is still valuable!
