Week Beginning: 24th September 2018

Maths:

We are continuing with place value work, extending this to addition and subtraction of numbers up to 6 digits and decimals with up to 3 decimal places. A focus on multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000 of any number or any decimal number is very important this week. We will also be learning all the tables facts and corresponding division facts.

English:

We are continuing with the 'Jungle Book' which we started this week. We will be discussing the differences between writing that dates back to the Victorian Period and that of Modern Day writers. We will be studying the style and conventions of writers like Rudyard Kipling and investigating how writers use narration and characters to tell the story. We will then be continuing to write in the style of these authors, attempting to achieve a 'lively and varied' narrative style.

Homework:

This will be maths, spellings, and tables. Any free writing that the children may want to do could be based on the text, e.g. writing in the style of Rudyard Kipling, but please make sure it is on lined paper and in pencil, thank-you.

Guided Reading:

Guided reading books remain the same as the previous week.
