

This week in Maths Class Two will be building on our place value work in numbers up to 200 for Year 2 and over 1,000 for Year 3 and 4, by solving a range of word problems and learning to explain our reasoning. You can help by continuing to write numbers up to 1,000 in sequence and say them aloud. With Mrs Thomson we extend our work on position and direction.

In English Class Two we will be beginning to read a fantastic non-fiction text called 'What to Look for in Autumn'. This has great illustrations and text to teach us about wildlife and what is happening in the countryside around us; and how to write a brilliant information text. We continue work on grammar, spelling and punctuation with Mrs Thomson.

We have had our first prize winners who have read for over 25 times at home. Well done! Many others are nearly there. Remember that just five minutes listening and quickly signing and dating counts towards the total. More of course is even better!
