

Week Beginning: 26<sup>th</sup> November 2018

This week we are continuing with methods for division, following on from the work with which we have done this week. Some of us will be using the 'chunking' method which we have started doing this week, others will be moving on to a more formal method, using a shortened version. We are encouraging the children to check with the inverse, i.e. multiplication and to estimate whether they think an answer is plausible.

In Literacy we are starting a unit of work about instructions and explanations, we will be reading a lot of instructions, following through oral instructions for making things and then starting to write our own instructions and explanations.

Guided reading books are as for previous weeks: Goodnight Mr. Tom, The Dream Maker and The diary of Anne Frank.

Grammar and spelling is to learn and understand the main word classes.

Homework is an hour using IXL, studying division and strategies for division and grammar.
