Dear Parents and Carers

We have been writing newspaper reports on the local area as part of our Literacy topic this term.

During the Foot and Mouth outbreak the area around the school featured heavily in the national news and I have arranged for the children in Class 2 to visit Watchtree Nature Reserve on Tuesday 12th February 2019.
