SUBJECT	ACTIVITIES
READING	Please read for at least 20 minutes every day. Reading material can include: recipes, comics, home and/or school reading books etc. The school also has access to Oxford Owl which has online books (login details have sent home).
SPELLING PHONICS	Please practice these spellings: Year One: today, said, were, was, your, do, to, are, were and is. Year Two: find, climb, hold, beautiful, grass, prove, people and parents. EYFS: Letter formation (see home learning pack pp.44-45).
ENGLISH COMMUNICATION/LANGUAGE	Year Two: Write a letter to the Prime Minister, Boris Johnson, in order to persuade him to stop giving children any homework.

	<p>Year One: Write a letter to Mrs. Goffin about what you've been doing at home.</p> <p>EYFS: Look at pictures of you and your family when they were younger and talk about similarities / differences. Discuss what you couldn't do at that time compared to now and what you are looking forward to doing in the future.</p>
MATHS	<p>Year Two: Use www.timetables.com to practice your tables.</p> <p>EYFS: Get a family member to time how long it takes you to get dressed independently in the morning – can you beat your time the next day?
