English	<p>Day 1</p> <p><i>Learning focus: reading and understanding a story, planning and writing instructions related to the story. Using imperative verbs in own creative writing.</i></p> <p>Children listen to This Book Just Ate my Dog using https://youtu.be/b9zcyjE2RDME.</p> <p>Children play a Racing Track game related to the book, which they can do without printing. They then design and draw their own game, also relating this to the book.</p>	<p>Day 2</p> <p><i>Learning focus: re-reading a story; writing descriptive phrases and sentences, writing a short imaginative narrative.</i></p> <p>Children listen again to the story on https://youtu.be/b9zcyjE2RDME. They look at the end page and see how Bella’s dog is jumbled up. Following this idea, children first produce a jumbled up picture with descriptions, and then create a jumbled up story, which they carefully write out.</p>	<p>Day 3</p> <p><i>Learning focus: reading and responding to a story; recalling the events in order; retelling part of the story using conjunctions in sentences.</i></p> <p>At https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q7ez-9Yuc_A&feature=youtu.be listen to My Uncle is a Hunkle by Lauren Child. Children use their memory skills to write a list of all the disasters that happen whilst Uncle Ted is looking after them. They can check how good they are at recalling the story! Then they select and write an account of the disaster that they thought was most amusing. They use descriptive language, extending their sentences using conjunctions.</p>	<p>Day 4</p> <p><i>Learning focus: revising the use of commas to write lists; identifying where commas should go in sentences, and writing own list sentences.</i></p> <p>Children listen again to https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q7ez-9Yuc_A&feature=youtu.be My Uncle is a Hunkle. They revise how we use commas to write lists and then add commas to sentences which are missing these. They also add the word ‘and’. Finally, they write a list sentence describing four things they would like Uncle Ted to bring in his rucksack, and then write a reason for their choices, using ‘because’.</p>	<p>Day 5</p> <p><i>Learning focus: listen to an advert, use this to plan, draft and write their own advert for a perfect babysitter</i></p> <p>Children watch a clip from Mary Poppins: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=VZJZh2ZTOqs and then think about what characteristics they would personally like – or NOT like – in a babysitter of their choice. They follow instructions to plan and draft an email to Child-Minders R Us, requesting their perfect babysitter.</p>
