I have been impressed with how the children have worked so far this term. Their learning is moving forward and in order to keep this momentum we will be setting homework through 'Doodle' as well as ongoing reading and times table practise.

Homework will be set as assignments that the children can access through their account. An App can be downloaded or a web browser can be used.

Your child's login details can be found inside the back cover of their reading record books.

Reception/ Year 1 and Year 2

- There will be a phonics book that will need to read by your child three times before it gets changed.
- A class phonics book will also be sent home. This is a book already read in class but will be a chance for your child to show off their reading. Again, this needs read by your child three times. Please sign and date their reading record so staff can change books appropriately
- A doodle maths and a doodle spell will be set for Year 1 and Year 2

Year 3/4/5/6

- Doodle maths, spelling and English tasks will be set.
- Children should read for a minimum of 10 minutes each day.
Year 3 and 4 children should be reading out loud to parents, please sign their reading record.
Year 5 and 6 children will benefit from reading out loud but some children will be capable of reading on their own and signing their own reading record.
- Children should access 'Times table rockstars' 3 times a week.

Homework tasks will usually be set from a Monday to the following Monday. Staff will monitor their completed assignments and reading.

Children can catch up with missed homework during playtimes and lunchtime but we would prefer parents and guardians help to keep children on top of their tasks to avoid this.
